2.2. Nomination process

The home university should send a nomination email to: international@truni.sk and include the following information: Name and Surname, email of the student, applied department, Level of Study, Applied semester.

2.3. Costs

Basic costs for food and accommodation can currently be estimated between 350€ - 400 €.

2.4. Housing

Trnava University provides accommodation for exchange students in the dormitory - "Petra Pázmaňa" dormitory on Rybníková street 13/A in Trnava in double-bed rooms. Since the number of places is limited, Erasmus+ students who submit their application forms to the IRO office early are given priority. The student's dormitory is within walking distance from campus. 2.5. Visa

EEA Citizens: For students from the European Economic Area (EU and EFTA countries) and Switzerland there are no specific requirements to enter Slovakia. A valid passport or national ID card is sufficient to enter Slovakia.

Other Nationals: For students from non-European Union or European Free Trade Association countries, an entry or residence permit for entry into and residence in Slovakia is required. 2.6. Health insurance

EU students only need their European Health Insurance Card.

Some countries have a national insurance agreement with Slovakia – students should enquire about the regulations and procedures.

For students from countries that have no national health insurance agreements with Slovakia, we strongly recommend purchasing health insurance from a commercial insurance company at your home country.

2.7. Grading system
